If you need further information or if I can be of assistance in any way, please let me know.

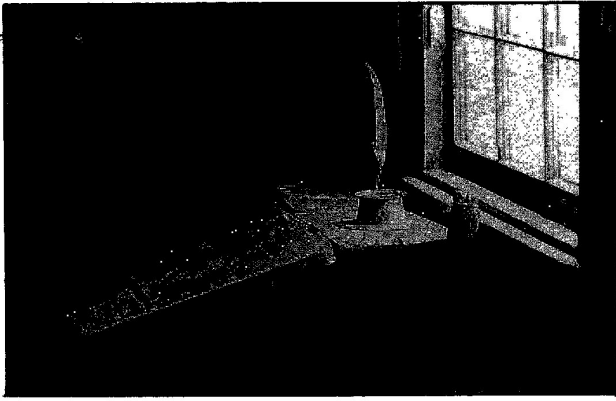

I have the original ms. much corrected that Christopher Morley wrote for the Saturday Review of Literature, beginning "It is seventy years since Emerson sat down to write (July 21, 1855) a letter etc etc not yet forgotten etc. for 7 pages.

I will be giving it to the collection at the Library of Congress. It was published about the middle of July. I'm sure its available at many libraries, including Huntington. You might like to print it with the letter as well as what you might like to write. Only an idea.
