Mr. WILLIAMS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

CENTER FOR MIGRATION STUDIES

A BILL

To grant an alien child adopted by an unmarried United States citizen the same immigrant status as an alien child adopted by a United States citizen and his spouse.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 101 (b) (1) (F) of the Immigration and Na-
4 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 (b) (1) (F)) is amended—

5 (1) by inserting before “by a United States citizen”

6 both times it occurs in such subparagraph the follow-

7 ing: “by an unmarried United States citizen or”, and

8 (2) by striking out “who have complied” in such

9 subparagraph and inserting in lieu thereof “who has or

10 have complied”.
